Conditions of Entry

Entrants are advised that some conditions of entry have altered so please check the new regulations carefully.

- 1. Entries close 6pm Wednesday. Late entries will NOT be accepted.
- **2.** The Judge has the right to disqualify an entry that does not conform to the Schedule.
- **3.** The Steward reserves the right to place photographs in a more appropriate class if they feel the entrant has incorrectly entered their exhibit.
- **4.** The Judge's word is final.
- 5. In the monochromatic, junior and juvenile subsections the steward reserves the right to split the class in to Commercial Size 10 x 15cm and over 10 x 15cm if the number of entries in any size is deemed suitable by the judge.
- **6.** As per the general rules and regulations of the Lithgow Show Society all entries are to be the

entrant's own work and must not have been displayed or received a prize at any other Lithgow

- 7. ALL photographs are to be mounted on white or black cardboard with a 2cm boarder for display purposes. Framed entries will not be accepted. Unmounted entries will not be accepted. Entries mounted in artists board will not be accepted.
- 8. Prints should not display a date stamp or entrants watermark. Watermarked photos will not be accepted.
- **9.** Prints should be labelled ON THE BACK with the entrant's full name, address and the class of entry and as otherwise directed in the class description.

10. Due to the size of our display area prints in larger sections must not exceed 21cm x 30cm (A4)

11. All entries in the general entry section will automatically be included for Grand *Champion

Photograph. Entries in the Challenge Photograph competition will not be judged for Grand Champion. If entrants wish their print to be judged in the general section a duplicate print must be provided.

- 12. Commercially processed, chemically processed and home PC printed prints are eligible.
- 13. Photographs may be taken by either digital camera or traditional film camera.
- **14.**Photographs entered by a teacher on behalf of students or class groups must be labelled with the

student's name, school group and age on the reverse. Each individual student must have a separate entry form. Teacher's signature is acceptable in this case in lieu of parent or guardian. The school crest or logo may be placed on the front of the article but not the student's name.

- 15. In the Junior and Juvenile Sections, the age of the entrant is their age as on the judging date rather than the age when the photograph was taken.
- **16.**Entries in local heritage classes must be taken within the Lithgow local area. This includes Hartley, Wallerawang, Portland, Cullen Bullen & Capertee areas. For a comprehensive definition of local please see the Equestrian Schedule.
- 17.All entries to be collected the Sunday after the show between

10am and 12 noon.

A special prize of \$50 and Rosette will be given to the first-place print.

Entries in this section are not eligible for judging for Grand Champion Photograph. If you wish your print to be judged in the general section and included for Grand Champion Print of Show a duplicate print must be provided and entered appropriately.



Monochromatic Prints

Any photograph containing shades of only one colour (including black and white or sepia). If toning is carried out, it must be over the total photograph; partial toning and/or the addition of one extra colour is not acceptable in a monochrome section.
